Syllabus for Classes III to IX (Mathematics, Science and English)

SYLLABUS (MATHEMATICS)

- Class III : Fun with numbers, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division, Comparison (Long, Short & Weight), Time and Calendar, play with patterns, Rupees and Paise, Measurement (Local Context)
- Class IV : Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division, Measurement, Geometrical Shape, Time, Days, Year (including local context), fraction, play with patterns.
- Class V : Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Factor and Multiple, Fraction & Decimal, Distance and Time, Measurement, Money, Concept of Area and perimeter, Shapes and Angles, Symmetry, Play with patterns, Map reading.
- Class VI : Knowing our numbers, whole numbers, playing with numbers, Basic geometrical ideas, understanding elementary shapes, Integers, Fraction, Decimals, Data Handling, Mensuration, Algebra, Ratio and Proportion.
- Class VII : Integers, Fraction & Decimals, Data Handling, Sample Equation, Lines and angles, the triangle and its properties, congruence of triangles, comparing quantities, Rational numbers, Perimeter and area, Algebraic Expressions, Exponents and powers.
- Class VIII : Rational numbers, Linear equations in one variable, understanding quadrilaterals, Data Handling, Squares and square roots, cube and cube roots, comparing quantities, Algebraic expressions and identities, Visualising solid shapes, mensuration, Exponents and powers, Direct and inverse proportions, Factorisation.
- Class IX : Number System; Polynomials; Coordinate Geometry; Linear Equation; Introduction of Euclid Geometry; Lines and Angles; Triangles; Quadrilaterals; Area; Circle; Mensuration; Trigonometry; Statistic; Probability.

SYLLABUS (SCIENCE)

- Class VI : Foods: Where does it come from ? Components of food , Fibre to fabrics, Sorting materials into group, Separation of substances, changes around us, getting to know plants, body movements, the living organisms and their surroundings, motion and measurement of distance, light shadow and reflections, electricity and circuits, fun with magnets, water ,air around us, garbage in and garbage out.
- Class vii : Nutrition in plants; nutrition in animals; fibre to fabric; heat; acids, bases & salts; physical and chemical changes; weather, climate & adaptations of animals to climate; winds, storms & cyclones; soil; respiration in organisms; transportation in animals & plants; reproduction in plants; motion and time; electric current and its effect; light ; water: a precious resources ; forest: our lifeline, waste water story.
- Classes viii : Crop production and management; microorganisms: friend and foe; synthetic fibres and plastic; materials: metals and non-metals; coal and petroleum; combustion and flame; conservation of plants and animals; cell- structure and functions; reproduction in animals; reaching the age of adolescence ; force and pressure; friction; sound; chemical effects of electric current; some natural phenomena; light; stars and the solar system; pollution of air and water.
- Class IX : Motion; Force and laws of motion; Gravitation; Work, energy and power; Cell : Waves & Sound; The fundamental unit of life; Tissue; Biological diversity; Human diseases; Transportation of substances inside the body and Food higher yields. Natural resources.

SYLLABUS (ENGLISH)

- Class VI : Vowels and consonants, Words and word groups, Subject & Predicate, Parts of speech, The Noun, The number, The Gender, The pronoun, The case, Determiners, The verb, The tense, Singular & plurals, Cries & sounds, Young ones of animals, occupations, useful vocabulary, Antonyms, correct spellings.
- Class VII : The infinitive & the Imperative, the participle & the Gerund, Auxiliary verbs & Defective verbs, Voice, The Adverb - its formation & comparison, The preposition, the Conjunction, Synonyms, Comparisons - one word for many, Smaller pieces, Homes, Things where kept, Games where played, they differ in senses common phrases.
- Class VIII : The same word used as different parts of speech, Analysis of simple sentences, kinds of sentences, Speech - Direct & Indirect, Punctuation, Diminutives, Payments, Proverbs, One word substitutes, They differ in sense, Double Derivatives, Distinguished, Verbal phrases, Note the difference.
- Class IX : Articles, Pronouns, Adjective, Syntax, Determiners, Verbs, Adverbs, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Non-finite Verbs, Auxiliary Verbs, Tenses, Voice, Direct and Indirect, Transformation of sentences and Punctuation.
