**Syllabus for Classes III to IX (Mathematics, Science and English)**

**SYLLABUS (MATHEMATICS)**

- Class III : Numbers and numerals; Addition & Subtraction; Multiplication & Division; Money & Time; Shapes and Designs; Measurement.
- Class IV : Numbers and Comparison of Numbers; Multiples and Factors; Addition and Subtraction; Multiplication and Division; Measurement; Time and Division; Field and Fences.
- Class V : Extension of Numbers; shapes, triangle and angles; Money and Time; Length, Perimeter and Area; Addition and Subtraction; Multiplication, Division and Simplification; Fractions and Decimals; Unitary Method.
- Class VI : Natural Numbers, Whole numbers, Integers; Roman Numerals; Percentage; Fraction & Decimals; HCF & LCM; Algebra; Parallel lines; Circles; Angles; Polygon and its type; Three Dimensional Shapes: Mensuration.
- Class VII : Integers; Fraction & Decimals, Rational Numbers; Ratio; Percentage; Profit and Loss; Simple Interest; Equations; Angles; Triangles; Transversal; Pythagoras Theorem; Congruence of Triangle; Perimeter and Area; Algebraic Expression; Exponents and power.
- Class VIII : Rational numbers; Squares & Square roots; Cube and cube roots; Percentage; Profit and loss; Ratio; Discount; Compound Interest; Linear Equations; Algebraic Expression, Identities; Understanding Quadrilaterals; Mensuration.
- Class IX : Number System; Polynomials; Co-ordinate Geometry; Linear Equations in two Variables; Lines and Angles; Triangle; Mensuration; Trigonometry.

**SYLLABUS (SCIENCE)**

- Class VI : Food: where does it come from?, Components of food, Fibre to fabric, Sorting materials into groups, Separation of substances, Changes around us, Getting to know plants, Body movements, The living organisms and their surroundings, Motion and measurement of distances, Light, shadows and reflections, Electricity and circuits, Fun with magnets, Water.
- Class VII : Nutrition in plants, Nutrition in animals, Fibre to fabric, Heat, acids, bases and salts, physical and chemical changes, Weather, Climate and adaptations of animals to climate, Winds, storms and cyclones, Soil, Respiration in organisms, Transportation in plants and animals, Reproduction in plants, Motion and time, Electric current and its effects, Light, Water: A precious resource.
- Class VIII : Crop production and management, Microorganisms: friend and foe, Synthetic fibres and plastics, Materials: Metals and non-metals, Coal and petroleum, Combustion and flame, Conservation of plants and animals, Cell: structure and functions, Reproduction in animals, Reaching the age of adolescence, Force and pressure, Friction, Sound, Chemical effects of electric current, Some natural phenomena, Light, Stars and the solar system.
- Class IX : Nature of matter, Pure substance and mixtures, Atoms and molecules, Symbols, formulas and equations, Structure of the atom, Motion, Force and laws of motion, Gravitation, Work, energy and power, Floatation, The fundamental unit of life: cell, Tissue, Biological diversity, Human diseases, Transportation of substances inside the body, Food-higher yields.

**SYLLABUS (ENGLISH)**

- Class VI : Vowels and consonants, Words and word groups, Subject & Predicate, Parts of speech, The Noun, The number, The Gender, The pronoun, The case, Determiners, The verb, The tense, Singular & plurals, Cries & sounds, Young ones of animals, occupations, useful vocabulary, Antonyms, correct spellings.
- Class VII : The infinitive & the Imperative, the participle & the Gerund, Auxiliary verbs & Defective verbs, Voice, The Adverb - its formation & comparison, The preposition, the Conjunction, Synonyms, Comparisons - one word for many, Smaller pieces, Homes, Things where kept, Games where played, they differ in senses common phrases.
- Class VIII : The same word used as different parts of speech, Analysis of simple sentences, kinds of sentences, Speech - Direct & Indirect, Punctuation, Diminutives, Payments, Proverbs, One word substitutes, They differ in sense, Double Derivatives, Distinguished, Verbal phrases, Note the difference.
- Class IX : Articles, Pronouns, Adjective, Syntax, Determiners, Verbs, Adverbs, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Non-finite Verbs, Auxiliary Verbs, Tenses, Voice, Direct and Indirect, Transformation of sentences and Punctuation.
